3. Transportation

Recently, there were 27 cases of COVID-19 on a Carnival cruise ship that sailed from Galveston, Texas, to Belize, and the CDC recommendations for "cruisers," suggesting that those who are at increased risk for severe illness from COVID-19 avoid cruise ships regardless of vaccination status. This includes older adults, people with certain medical conditions, and pregnant and recently pregnant people. Before the new announcement, the CDC recommended that only people who were not fully vaccinated against COVID-19 avoid cruise ships.

Masks will still be required on airplanes, trains, and buses (as well as at airports and train stations) through January 18, 2022, according to the National Transportation Authority. Aside from adhering to mask mandates, the CDC also now recommends that domestic travelers delay travel until they are fully vaccinated, as well as get tested one to three days before the trip and again three to five days after travel. It's also important to stay home and self-quarantine for a full seven days after travel, even if you test negative, the CDC states.

As far as school buses, there's some good news for parents. The risk of acquiring COVID-19 on the school bus is very low when proper precautions are taken, including open windows, mandated masking, and two kids per seat.
