A Mature Witness Is Courageous and Fearless

Another characteristic of a mature witness is that he is courageous and fearless in sharing the gospel. As mentioned previously, [Acts 28:31](#) shares how Paul preached the Word boldly to all who came. It says, "Boldly and without hindrance he preached the kingdom of God and taught about the Lord Jesus Christ."

Not only was he preaching boldly, other Christians started to preach boldly because of him. [Philippians 1:14](#) actually says "most of the brothers" were encouraged to speak the Word of God "more courageously and fearlessly."

With Christians being persecuted in Rome, many of the saints ceased to share their faith for fear of persecution and its potential effects on their jobs and family. However, when these Christians saw Paul's bold witness while in prison and facing death, they began to boldly and fearlessly share the gospel as well. No longer were they afraid of losing their jobs—no longer were they afraid of what people thought or of people being offended. They became fearless.

“6 Places You’re Most Likely to Catch Coronavirus” (Pt.5)

4. Crowded beaches and pools

Reminder: Just because you’re outside, it doesn’t mean you’re safe.

Coronavirus infection rates at beaches surged last year as the weather warmed up and beachgoers hit the waves. In July, there was an outbreak in the Cape Cod resort town of Provincetown, where a total of 469 people developed COVID-19—three-quarters of whom had gotten their COVID vaccinations.

Luckily, beaches allow more airflow than indoor environments, and there is little evidence that the virus can spread to people through water. But experts believe that viral particles can still travel from an infected person to others nearby, especially in places where people linger for hours at a time. This is why the CDC recommends wearing a mask and avoiding crowded areas where you can’t stay six feet apart from other beachgoers.

Public pools may also be more problematic than you realize, says Dr. Horowitz. “When you are swimming, you are often breathing heavily, and your risk of catching COVID-19 depends on how close you are to someone who is not vaccinated,” he explains, noting that many of those in public pools are kids under 12 who may not have gotten vaccinated yet.

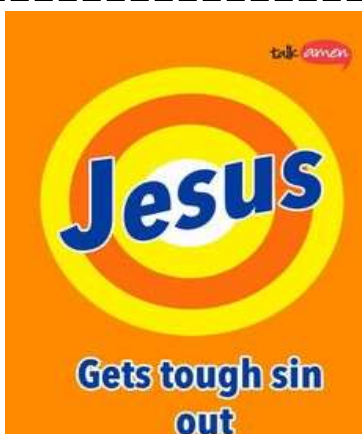
