Most Addictions are Sinful

Sinful behaviors are sinful, whether or not they're an addiction.

For example: Illegal drug use and pornography are sinful, whether they're addictions or not.

Lawful behaviors, on the other hand, can become sinful in certain circumstances.

Paul says, "All things are lawful for me, but not all things are profitable. All things are lawful for me, but I will not be mastered by anything" (1 Cor. 6:12).

Stay Away from Sinful Behaviors

If we have a godly attitude, we will stay away from sin. Thus, it is less likely we will involve ourselves in sinful behaviors that are highly addictive.

Paul sets forth this idea in these Scriptures:

1 Th. 5:21-22 "But examine everything carefully; hold fast to that which is good; abstain from every form of evil."

- **Rom. 12:9** "Let love be without hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil; cling to what is good."
- **1 Cor. 15:33** "Do not be deceived: Bad company corrupts good morals."

COVID-19 vaccination will help keep you from getting COVID-19

- All COVID-19 vaccines currently available in the United States have been shown to be highly effective at preventing COVID-19. Learn more about the different COVID-19 vaccines.
- All COVID-19 vaccines that are in development are being carefully evaluated in clinical trials and will be authorized or approved only if they make it substantially less likely you'll get COVID-19. Learn more about how federal partners are ensuring COVID-19 vaccines work.
- Based on what we know about vaccines for other diseases and early data from clinical trials, experts believe that getting a COVID-19 vaccine may also help keep you from getting seriously ill even if you do get COVID-19.
- Getting vaccinated yourself may also protect people around you, particularly people at increased risk for severe illness from COVID-19.
- Experts continue to conduct more studies about the effect of COVID-19 vaccination on severity of illness from COVID-19, as well as its ability to keep people from spreading the virus that causes COVID-19.

COVID-19 vaccination is a safer way to help build protection

- COVID-19 can have serious, life-threatening complications, and there is no way to know how COVID-19 will affect you.
