## Grown and Evangelizing (Part 9)

**2. Boldness is a result of watching and partnering with other bold witnesses.**

We can be sure Paul did this not only by his example in prison but also by challenging the church to share their faith. We see this with Philemon whom he wrote to while also imprisoned in Rome. In the letter, he said, "I pray that you may be active in sharing your faith, so that you will have a full understanding of every good thing we have in Christ" (**Philemon 1:6**).

He prays that Philemon would be active in sharing his faith so that he could fully know the blessings we have in Christ. As you can imagine, this would have been very challenging coming from a man who was in prison for sharing the faith. While Paul was in Rome, he called the church to stand up and be pioneers—he called them to be mature witnesses.

Paul did this not only so the lost could hear the gospel, but because he realized sharing was important for Christians to grow. With Philemon, Paul said that if he shared his faith, the result would be coming to a "full understanding of every good thing we have in Christ." Paul realized that if Philemon shared the gospel that God would give more understanding of himself—more grace.

Christians who faithfully share God's Word—God can entrust with more.

“COVID-19 symptoms and the Omicron variant: What the latest studies show” (Pt.3)

Investigations of outbreaks outside of South Africa have turned up similar trends.

One analysis of data compiled from reports of positive cases in London, where Omicron cases surged last month, tallied the top five symptoms as runny nose, headache, fatigue, sneezing, and sore throat.

Among mostly vaccinated people infected at a Christmas party in Norway, cough and runny nose showed up in more than three-quarters of the 81 cases. Only 12% reported reduced smell and 23% reported reduced taste.

In an Omicron outbreak between five reinfected people in a Nebraska household, a recent report published by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention found none had reported loss of taste or smell — compared to four during their first bout of COVID-19 in 2020. Two had a fever from their reinfection. One additional unvaccinated person, who had not been previously diagnosed with COVID-19, reported "cough, joint pain, congestion, fever, and chills."
