"What is Thrombocytopenia? Rare Blood Disorder Reported"
After COVID Vaccines

Over two dozen cases of the rare blood disorder thrombocytopenia have been reported in people who have received COVID vaccines in the U.S. However, a link between COVID vaccines and the disease that affects platelets has not been proven.

The Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting System (VAERS), which is jointly run by the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the U.S. Food and Drug Administration, is recording any potential side-effects experienced by people after they receive a vaccine.

By the end of January, 32 cases of a decreased platelet count, 14 cases of thrombocytopenia, and 11 cases of immune thrombocytopenia were reported in people who has received either Pfizer or Moderna COVID vaccines in the U.S. More than 43 million vaccine doses have been administered in the U.S.

Last month, a man in Florida died after developing thrombocytopenia days after getting vaccinated against COVID. 56-year-old Miami-based doctor Gregory Michael started displaying the symptoms of a form of the disorder called idiopathic thrombocytopenic purpura (ITP) days after receiving the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine. He died two weeks later from a brain hemorrhage. Newsweek has contacted Pfizer and Moderna for comments.
