Caring for Our Elderly Saints (Part 3)

What are the Treatment Options for COVID-19? (Part 2)

This virus can be preventable, but it will take more than just the vaccination. **We must follow the three Cs:**

- **Cover:** Always wear a two- or three-ply face mask (like a surgical mask) when you are around others or in public. Don't wear bandanas or gaiter face coverings.
- **Control:** Control your environment. If necessary, interact with others outdoors while maintaining a distance.
- **Contain:** Minimize gatherings. Walk or sit six feet or more away from one another. Do not trust anyone who does not live full time in your home.

Can you still get the COVID-19 infection after you get the vaccine? **Dr. Okun:** Yes. Even after being vaccinated, you can still be infected with COVID-19, spread it and experience COVID-19 symptoms. In most cases, we are predicting the symptoms will be less severe. **The data strongly suggests that COVID-19 is much less likely to be deadly after receiving two shots of the vaccine.**

Do I still need to wear a mask if I get the COVID-19 vaccine?

Dr. Okun: Yes. You still need to wear a mask and keep at six- to – 12-foot distance after receiving the vaccine. We are still seeing high numbers of the virus spreading among people who are in public and do not protect themselves.
