Chronic Kidney Disease-PART 2

In the early stages of kidney disease, you may not have any symptoms. In the late stages of CKD, many symptoms may appear at the same time. They will have a direct connection to significant loss of kidney function. Today we will talk about the symptoms of Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD).

CRAMPS: manly leg cramps are common for those with kidney disease. They are caused by fluid imbalance, nerve damage, blood flow problems with decrease electrolytes = low calcium and phosphorus levels will cause muscle cramping. The body needs calcium for muscles to move and for nerves to carry messages between your brain and every part of your body. Calcium also helps blood vessels to move blood throughout your body and helps release hormones that affects many functions in your body.

FEELING WEAK AND TRIED: a severe decrease in kidney functions can lead to a buildup of toxin and impurities in the blood. This can cause people to feel tired, weak and can make it hard to concentrate.

NAUSEA / VOMITING: most cases of acute kidney infection are caused by decrease blood flow to the kidneys. Resulting from low blood volume after bleeding, excessive vomiting, diarrhea, or severe dehydration. Many people experience these symptoms during hemodialysis due to the rapid drop in blood pressure.

ITCHY SKIN: persistently itchy skin may be felt all over the body. It is due to the buildup of wastes that the kidney can no longer filter out.

LOSS OF APPETITE: in the early to middle stages of kidney disease, waste products buildup in the blood, suppresses appetite and will affect your sense of taste. Foods you once enjoyed will taste metallic. Difficult Breathing: decreased oxygen from fluid buildup in the lungs.

SWELLING: of the face, hands, feet and ankles from ineffective removal of fluid by the kidneys.

PAIN: in the side or mid lower back, occurring when one kidney fails. CKD can cause kidney stones and fluid – filled cysts to develop causing increased pain severity.
