Application Question: In what ways have you seen or experienced attacks for being a faithful witness for Christ? How can we practice a wise response to attacks? What does a wise response look like?

A Mature Witness Has the Right Motives The latter do so in love, knowing that I am put here for the defense of the gospel. (Philippians 1:16)

Application Question: What are possible wrong motives one might have in sharing the gospel or serving in ministry?

Another characteristic of a mature witness is having the right motives. Why do we share the gospel with others? Why do we serve in children's ministry, youth ministry, or worship ministry? What are our motives?

In this scenario, we see both those who served out of envy and rivalry and those who served out of love. Let us realize that a lot of ministry is done out of wrong motives. The disciples commonly argued about who was the greatest. A competitive spirit was still in them from their life in the world. Many churches are competitive. I talked with one pastor who previously started a church plant in a city. Reducing COVID's Toll (Part 4)

Many Americans still have not gotten this message, though. What might help? A prominent public-service campaign, focused specifically on booster shots rather than vaccination, could. So could encouragement from politically conservative voices.

Fewer than 30 percent of Republican adults have received a booster; many Republicans <u>have not received even a first shot.</u>

"The most powerful weapon we have, by far, is vaccination," Richterman told me, "and that includes first doses, second doses and third doses."

What about fourth doses (that is, second booster shots)? The Biden administration will soon begin offering them to anybody 50 or older. The evidence suggests that these shots may offer additional protection but that they are less important than first booster shots, as Katelyn Jetelina, an epidemiologist, <a href="https://has.explained">has.explained</a> in her newsletter.

#### 2. The immunocompromised

For a small percentage of Americans, vaccination is impossible or ineffective. This group includes people who are receiving cancer treatments and those who have received certain organ transplants.
