What are the Treatment Options for COVID-19? (Part 3)

Do I still need to wear a mask if I get the COVID-19 vaccine?

Dr. Okun: Yes. If you get the vaccine, you can still be infected with COVID-19, and spread it. If you do not wear a mask you could spread the virus to someone else without even knowing it, and this could have serious health consequences for others — especially the elderly and at-risk groups. Remember to cover, control and contain.

If I had COVID-19 should I still get the vaccine? Dr. Okun: Yes.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends waiting a few weeks after you recover from COVID-19. At UF Health, we have health professionals who have contracted COVID-19 and were vaccinated. We do not know if having COVID-19 will help you develop and maintain the antibodies necessary to fight off the disease.

Risk and mortality are so high with this virus that we recommend receiving the vaccination as soon as you can after infection with COVID-19. Following current CDC guidelines, most doctors wait several weeks after infection before vaccination.
