Why Does God Allow Good People to Suffer? (Part 3)

Note the texts in **2 Corinthians, Chapter 4** indicate the sufferings of Paul and his associates: **11** For we who live are constantly being delivered over to death for Jesus' sake, that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our mortal flesh. **12** So death works in us, but life in you (**4:11-12, NASB**). Let's move to **2 Corinthians, Chapter 6:3** giving no cause for offense in anything, in order that the ministry be not discredited, **4** but in everything commending ourselves as servants of God, in much endurance, in afflictions, in hardships, in distresses, **5** in beatings, in imprisonments, in tumults, in labors, in sleeplessness, in hunger, **6** in purity, in knowledge, in patience, in kindness, in the Holy Spirit, in genuine love, **7** in the word of truth, in the power of God; by the weapons of righteousness for the right hand and the left, **8** by glory and dishonor, by evil report and good report; *regarded* as deceivers and yet true; **9** as unknown yet well-known, as dying yet behold, we live; as punished yet not put to death, **10** as sorrowful yet always rejoicing, as poor yet making many rich, as having nothing yet possessing all things (**6:3-10, NASB**). **2 Corinthians 7:5** reads: For even when we came into Macedonia our flesh had no rest, but we were afflicted on every side: conflicts without, fears within. **2 Corinthians, Chapter 11: 23** Are they servants of Christ? (I speak as if insane) I more so; in far more labors, in far more imprisonments, beaten times without number, often in danger of death. **24** Five times I received from the Jews thirty-nine lashes.

Rumor, Disparity and Distrust: Why Black Americans Face an Uphill Battle Against COVID-19 (Part 3)

The concern that black communities presently hampered by health inequities could be devastated by the coronavirus is rooted in decades of research as well as the nation's checkered racial history. **African Americans suffer from higher rates of conditions like asthma, obesity, diabetes and kidney disease – problems that experts say could make COVID-19 more damaging if they get it. African Americans "also have less access to health insurance and paid sick leave, and poorer access to quality health care," Cooper notes.** Research indicates African Americans are more likely than whites to rely on hospital emergency rooms for primary care – departments that soon may be overwhelmed with anticipated surges of COVID-19 patients. **What's more, because many black Americans hold hourly, low-wage jobs, "fear of lost wages or loss of employment may lead African Americans and other vulnerable Americans to try to work when they are ill, contributing to further spread of the disease within their communities," Cooper says.**
