What are the Treatment Options for COVID-19? (Part 3)

Are there side effects from the vaccine? Dr. Okun: Side effects are mostly local and occur in the region of the injection (the shoulder in most cases). The vaccine goes into the muscle and works up your immune system (we recommend receiving it in your non-dominant arm). The most likely side effect you may experience is a sore arm for a few days, with complete use of the arm. When you return for your second shot, about half of people will experience mild to moderate flu-like symptoms and possibly a fever for a day or two — try to avoid work or public places for those days if you can. **This adverse reaction is a good thing. It is a sign that your immune system is working hard, NOT that you have COVID-19.**

Relatively common side effects include:
