Why Does God Allow Good People to Suffer? (Part 5)

Paul suffers the entire gamut of afflictions. Many of the afflictions to which Paul refers in 2 Corinthians are not described in the book of Acts. Those recorded by Luke, who wrote Acts, are thus only the "tip of the iceberg" of Paul's afflictions. He suffers from hunger, thirst, from heat and cold, from physical attacks, from illnesses, from constant threats on his life, and from betrayal and false accusations. His intelligence (or at least his wisdom), his homiletical skills, and his apostolic authority are challenged and sometimes mocked. He is accused of being fickle and failing to fulfill his promises. He is said to be strong in his written words but a wimp in person. And if suffering at the hands of men and nature is not enough, we are also informed that Paul suffered at the hand of Satan (12:7-10). We know that this demonic affliction would not have been gentle but would have been purposed for his spiritual and physical destruction. No epistle describes the afflictions of this great apostle more clearly than 2 Corinthians. When Paul speaks about suffering, he speaks from experience.

While the entire epistle of 2 Corinthians supplies us with much information concerning Paul's afflictions, Paul gives us a very graphic snapshot of the suffering he experienced just prior to the writing of this epistle: 8 For we do not want you to be unaware, brethren, of our affliction which came to us in Asia, that we were burdened excessively, beyond our strength, so that we despaired even of life; 9 indeed, we had the sentence of death within ourselves in order that we should not trust in ourselves. but in God who raises the dead; **10** who delivered us from so great a peril of death, and will deliver us, He on whom we have set our hope. And He will yet deliver us, (2 Corinthians 1:8-10, NASB).

HealthCare Ministry Latest Update on COVID-19 (Part 1) Submitted by: Beatrice Ramsey

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) issued an emergency use authorization (EUA) for the antiviral drug <u>remdesivir</u> to treat people hospitalized with severe illness from the coronavirus. Preliminary results from a clinical trial testing the drug as a potential treatment for COVID-19 found that sick patients who received remdesivir recovered faster than similar patients who received a placebo, according to an announcement made earlier in the week from the National Institutes of Health. "Based on evaluation of the emergency use authorization criteria and the scientific evidence available, it was determined that it is reasonable to believe that remdesivir may be effective in treating COVID-19, and that, given there are no adequate, approved, or available alternative treatments, the known and potential benefits to treat this serious or life-threatening virus currently outweigh the known and potential risks of the drug's use," the FDA said in a news release.

The race to find a vaccine for the coronavirus continues. Anthony Fauci, M.D., director of the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases **(NIAID)** and a key member of the White House coronavirus task force, said he thinks it's "doable" to have a vaccine ready by January "if things fall into the right place." Nearly 100 research teams around the world are working on vaccine development, according to the Milken Institute's **COVID-19** Treatment and Vaccine Tracker.

A new report from the Center for Infectious Disease Research and Policy predicts the coronavirus outbreak could last 18 to 24 months, based on what we know from recent flu pandemics. The **researchers note** it **"likely won't be halted until <u>60</u> to <u>70</u> percent of the population is immune."**

A handful of states and communities across the country are starting the three-phased process of reopening their economies. Older adults and people at high risk for complications associated with COVID-19 are encouraged to continue to stay home as much as possible and to limit contact with others during the first two phases of reopening plans.
