HealthCare Ministry After You've Been Fully Vaccinated, You Can Do This Submitted by: Beatrice Ramsey

After you've been fully vaccinated, you can wear a mask on planes, buses, trains, and other forms of public transportation traveling into. within, or out of the United States, and in U.S. transportation hubs such as airports and stations. Fully vaccinated international travelers arriving in the United States are still required to get tested within 3 days of their flight (or show documentation of recovery from COVID-19 in the past 3 months) and should still get tested 3-5 days after their

- You should still watch out for symptoms of COVID-19, especially if you've been around someone who is sick. If you have symptoms of COVID-19, you should get tested and stay home and away from others.
- You will still need to follow the guidance at your workplace.
- People who have a condition or are taking medications that weaken the immune system, should talk to their healthcare provider to discuss their activities. They may need to keep taking all precautions to prevent COVID-19.

Things to Remember - When choosing safer activities. consider how COVID-19 is spreading in your community, the number of people participating in the activity, and the location of the activity.
