## Conjunctivitis (Pink Eye)

Pink eye is inflammation of the transparent membrane that lines the eyelid and eyeball. This membrane is called the conjunctiva. When small blood vessels in the conjunctiva become swollen and irritated, they become more visible. This causes the whites of the eyes to appear reddish or pink. **COMPLICATIONS:** Pink eye can cause inflammation in the cornea that will affect vision. Prompt evaluation and treatments by your doctor can reduce the risk of complications. Such as eye pain, a feeling that something is stuck in your eye, blurred vision, and light sensitivity. The most common symptoms are redness in one or both eyes, tearing and a discharge in one or both eyes that forms a crust during the night, that may prevent your eye or eyes from opening in the morning.

THE THREE TYPES OF CONJUNCTIVITIS: 1) Viral conjunctivitis is very contagious and is often spread in crowded places. It causes a watery discharge, from the affected eye or eyes. By the same virus that causes runny nose and sore throat in people with a common cold. 2) Bacterial conjunctivitis is also very contagious. You will have soreness with a lot of sticky pus in the eye. Sometimes the bacterial infection is the same bacteria that causes strep throat. 3) Allergic conjunctivitis comes from an allergic reaction to pollen, animals, pool chlorine, smoke, flowers and car fumes. Itis not contagious, eyes become itchy, red and watery with puffy eyelids. PREVENTING THE SPREAD OF PINK EYE: Follow these steps to prevent infecting others and re-infecting yourself. Try not to touch your eyes, if you do wash your hands immediately. Because the infection is on your hands. Use a clean towel or tissue each time you wipe your face or your eyes. Do not use eye makeup or share with others, because bacteria can live inside of makeup material. It is recommended not to wear contact lenses until the eye infection is completely eliminated. Change your pillowcases often and don't share towels and washcloths.


