### Some Valuable Nuggets on Forgiveness Ephesians 4:32 (Part 2)

Some of us have been abused emotionally, physically, or sexually as children by your parents or by trusted family members. Some of us have children who were abused by your mate or by a family member. Some have been betrayed by an unfaithful spouse whom you loved and cared for deeply. These kinds of wrongs are not easy to forgive.

But if you're a Christian, seeking and granting forgiveness are not optional. Jesus said that if you do not forgive others, the heavenly Father will not forgive you (**Matt. 6:15; Mark 11:25**). Scholars are divided over whether that refers to being under God's eternal judgment or to your relationship with the Father as His child. I favor the second option. But either way, you don't want to miss out on the Father's forgiveness! Jesus said that forgiving others is so important that if you are worshiping God when you remember that your brother has something against you, you should first go be reconciled to your brother and then come back to worship God (**Matt. 5:23-24**). So, it is vital for you as a Christian to grapple with understanding and practicing forgiveness. Since many books have been written on this topic, I can only touch on some of the issues.

In the context, Paul is showing specific ways that we are to put on the new man, "which in the likeness of God has been created in righteousness and holiness of the truth" (**4:24**). We are to put away all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and slander (**4:31**).

### “What Doctors Wish Patients Knew About the Johnson & Johnson Vaccine”

After receiving emergency use authorization from the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), Johnson & Johnson-owned Janssen Pharmaceuticals became the third company to make its coronavirus vaccine available in the country. The Johnson & Johnson (J&J) SARS-CoV-2 viral vector vaccine joined mRNA vaccines made by Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna to help prevent more severe COVID19 outcomes, including hospitalizations and death.

The J&J one-shot vaccine for adults was another major step toward vaccinating millions of people across the country. While its single-dose, easy-to-store logistical advantages make it an attractive option, it's important to understand why there was a recent pause in J&J vaccine administration due to a rare brain blood clot combined with low platelets—cerebral venous sinus thrombosis with thrombocytopenia (TTS). These adverse events were identified through the Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting System, which is jointly managed by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and FDA.

Among nearly 8 million doses of the J&J vaccine administered through April, the FDA and CDC reviewed data involving 15 reported cases in the U.S. of cerebral TTS in people receiving the vaccination.

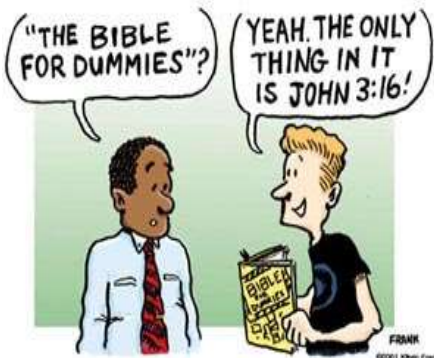
