### Why Does God Allow Good People to Suffer? (Part 7)

It is important to recognize that the expression "Blessed be...." is occasioned by suffering. Paul's praise flows out of his growing love for God, as enhanced by his suffering. How can Paul praise God because of his suffering? That is what we are about to learn. The answer to our question can be found in several statements which sum up several reasons God's people suffer at the hand of a God who is both good and great.

**(1) To suffer is divine.** You have probably heard it said, "To err is human, to forgive divine." I believe the Apostle Paul indicates that to suffer is both human and divine. Suffering is human because it comes with our humanity. We are fallen creatures living in a fallen world. As a result, there is, and will be, sin and suffering until the kingdom of God is established at the second coming of our Lord (see **Romans 8:18-25**). Suffering is divine because ultimately it comes to us from the hand of God. We suffer because God has willed us to suffer. Even Joseph's seemingly innocent suffering at the hands of his jealous brothers was a part of God's plan, which was for the good of Joseph and his family (see **Genesis 50:20**). **The first step we must take for our suffering to produce blessing (for us and others) is to acknowledge that our suffering has come to us from God:**

Therefore, let those also who suffer according to the will of God entrust their souls to a faithful Creator in doing what is right (**1 Peter 4:19**).

Suffering is divine when it is the suffering of the saints for living righteous lives.

#### “How Much Do Masks Help Against COVID-19?”

New evidence suggests the novel **coronavirus might be able to spread through the air**. It also seems to be **contagious even though people don't have symptoms** to show they are infected. Those two worrisome findings led the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, last month, **to recommend that everyone wear masks over their noses and mouths in public**. With medical-grade masks in short supply, CDC recommended that these be reserved for health care workers. The public was advised to look for cloth masks they could buy or make at home.

The **best guard against airborne viruses** are known as **N95 masks**. These are what hospital workers sometimes use around people who may be sick. They are different from the masks that doctors and nurses wear in surgery. With N95 masks in short supply, the medical community has been asking the public to reserve their use for hospital teams and first responders. But people can buy or make fabric masks. If a sick person wears one of these, the mask may catch most of their germ droplets of spit or nasal mucus. That could limit the virus from getting onto surfaces that others might touch. But these masks are designed to protect people from the mask-wearer, not the other way around. **And no mask is a replacement for hand washing and social distancing.**
