Some Valuable Nuggets on Forgiveness Ephesians 4:32 (Part 3)

In the context, Paul is showing specific ways that we are to put on the new man, "which in the likeness of God has been created in righteousness and holiness of the truth" (4:24). We are to put away all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and slander (4:31).

We are to replace these sins with kindness, tenderheartedness, and forgiveness, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you (4:32). Now we want to focus on what it means to forgive and how we can practically apply it.

To forgive others, we must understand the nature of forgiveness and the perspective needed for it, and we must take action to demonstrate forgiveness.

1. To forgive others, we must understand the nature of forgiveness.

What does it mean to ask forgiveness or to forgive someone? There is a lot of misunderstanding here. One writer put it this way, that apologizing is the world's substitute for forgiving. He points out that there is not a single reference in the Bible to apologizing. It is an unbiblical concept. It allows the wrongdoer to tell you how he feels ("I'm sorry") without acknowledging his sin and it does not ask the one sinned against to grant forgiveness.

He also pointed out that biblical forgiveness does not mean accepting the other person in his sin, which often amounts to condoning sin. Again, this is often the world's way.

“What Doctors Wish Patients Knew About the Johnson & Johnson Vaccine” (Part 2)

Among nearly 8 million doses of the J&J vaccine administered through April, the FDA and CDC reviewed data involving 15 reported cases in the U.S. of cerebral TTS in people receiving the vaccination. Most were in women between 18 and 48, with symptoms developing six to 13 days after vaccination. Since the pause has been lifted, the J&J Janssen vaccine is recommended for those 18 or older under an amended FDA emergency use authorization, which includes additional warnings and precautions, especially for women under 50.

Two physician experts took time to share what patients should know about the J&J vaccine: AMA Chief Health and Science Officer Mira Irons, MD, and Sandra Fryhofer, MD, an Atlanta general internist who serves as the AMA's liaison to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP). Dr. Fryhofer also is a member of ACIP's COVID-19 Vaccine Work Group.

Only one dose is needed

The J&J vaccine “is the first authorized vaccine to require one dose instead of two,” said Dr. Irons during an episode of the “AMA COVID-19 Update” about the Janssen COVID-19 vaccine.
