Why Does God Allow Good People to Suffer? (Part 10)

When we watch television, we know when a writer is setting us up so that we not only hope to see the villain die, we hope he or she will die a horrible death. Of the many ways to die, some are much more agonizing than others for the one dying. Paul tells us he is sure he will die, and he believes his death will be one of great torment.

The picture could not have been bleaker for the apostle at this moment in time. Humanly speaking, Paul's situation is hopeless, which is precisely the way God wants it to be. In such circumstances, Paul cannot trust in himself; he can trust only in God. And since he is certain to die, He must trust in the God who raises the dead. This kind of suffering, which appears to spell Paul's demise, is actually a friend to Paul, because *it brings him to a point where he and every other Christian must be—the point of trusting not in ourselves but in God who raises the dead.*

(3) Suffering as a saint is God's means of drawing us into closer communion with Him. Suffering as saints enables us to know God as we would not otherwise know Him. If it were not for sin, we could not know the grace of God manifested in the sacrificial death of our Lord Jesus Christ. If it were not for Satan, and for all those who oppose our God, we should not know His omniscience (all-knowing) and omnipotence (all-powerful). If it were not for suffering, we would not know God's mercy, compassion, and comfort. *Suffering is a divinely appointed means of knowing God intimately.*

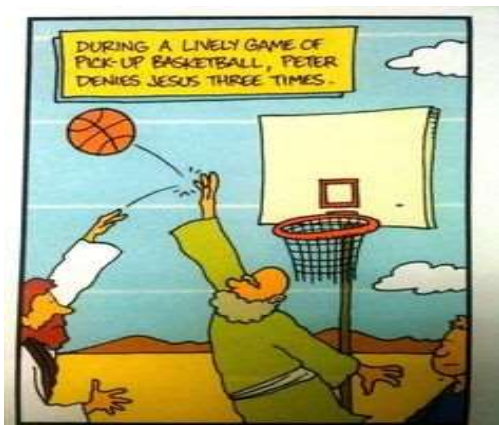
“10 Ways to Stay Healthy During Coronavirus Pandemic”

1. **Wash your hands!** - Often. Assume that sneezes or germ hands have left infectious residues on every surface that you have not personally cleaned or seen cleaned (especially outside your home). Scrub away for 20 seconds. (Sing the Happy Birthday song twice — and not quickly — while you wash.) Don't forget to wash between fingers and under nails. If soap and water is unavailable, you can disinfect hands with an alcohol-based hand sanitizer. Another option: If you have to turn a doorknob, put a clean tissue or paper towel between the knob and your hand.

2. **Disinfect surfaces.** - These include desktops, phone keypads, computer keyboards, TV remotes, door handles and kitchen counters. Rub them down with a rag or paper towel that has been dampened with alcohol-based disinfectant. (Don't get electronics wet. A dampened rag is sufficient and won't harm your devices.)

3. **Don't eat food or handle dishes or utensils touched by a sick family member.** - If you must touch a spoon someone else has handled (but not had in their mouth), do so. Then wash your hands.
