Gingivitis: Gum Disease

Gingivitis is inflammation of the gums. Many people have inflamed gums every now and then, usually doesn't cause any major problems at the beginning. But it may spread to other parts of the soft tissue and bone, responsible for keeping your teeth firmly anchored. It's important to take gingivitis seriously and treat it immediately. Gingivitis untreated will lead to tooth loss. **CAUSES:** The most common cause of inflamed gums is plaque. This is the thin film that is mainly made of bacteria and is barely visible at first. It is found where the tooth and gum meet, it may feel 'furry' when you run your tongue over it. "**DID YOU KNOW**"? The bacteria in the plaque 'eat' sugars from food in your mouth, and their waste products can cause the gums to become inflamed and swollen. Other causes include smoking, diabetes, certain medications, hormonal changes during pregnancy, older age, dry mouth, poor oral care, and poor nutrition including vitamin C deficiency.

Gingivitis sometimes goes away, but it can last a long time. If gingivitis persists, the pockets between the tooth and gums might become deeper, sometimes up to 1 centimeter deep. Bacteria start growing in these gum pockets, and no longer possible to reach the bacteria with a toothbrush. A layer of bacterial plaque builds up on the root and neck of the tooth, where it become harden. This hard substance is known as tartar and can only be removed by a dental professional. If bacteria and tartar get worse, they will break down the jawbone around the teeth, exposing the roots of the teeth. They will become loose and painful, requiring removal. **SYMPTOMS:** swollen or puffy dark red gums, bleeding easily when you brush or floss and tender gums. **PREVENTION:** brush your teeth fortwo minutes, in the morning and before going to bed. If possible, brush after each meal or snack. Even better, flossing before you brush allows you to clean away the loosened food particles and bacteria. Make regular dental visits for cleaning every 6 to 12 months.




