Some Valuable Nuggets on Forgiveness Ephesians 4:32 (Part 8)

A. BIBLICAL FORGIVENESS IS THE DECISION.

Here are the Last Aspect of Forgiveness:

5. To be reconciled with the offender as far as is biblically possible.

God forgives us so that we may be reconciled to Him and enjoy a close relationship with Him. When we forgive others, we should also seek to restore the broken relationship. This does not always mean becoming best of friends, but it should at least mean that we are cordial and friendly towards the person. To say, "I forgive you, but I never want to see your ugly face again," is not to forgive as God forgives! Of course, if the offender does not truly repent of his sin, we cannot be truly reconciled or in a close relationship. But even then, we are still commanded to love our enemies, do good to those who hate us, bless those who curse us, and pray for those who mistreat us (**Luke 6:27-28**).

So, biblical forgiveness is a decision to release the offender from the guilt of his sin, to refuse to bring up the offense to use against him, to refuse to think about the offense, to refuse to talk to others about the offense, and to be reconciled to the offender if possible. Also, to understand forgiveness we must realize that...

B. BIBLICAL FORGIVENESS IS COSTLY.

It cost God the death of His beloved Son. It will not usually cost us that much, but it still may be very costly.

"What Doctors Wish Patients Knew About the Johnson & Johnson Vaccine" (Part 6)

You have other vaccine choices

The FDA updated the J&J Janssen vaccine EUA with an additional warning, noting that "women under 50 should be made aware of a rare risk of blood clots and low platelets following vaccination," said Dr. Fryhofer. "They also need to know there are other COVID vaccines out there that don't pose this small risk.

"That empowers patient choice. It also means vaccination clinics should make clear which vaccine or vaccines are being offered and when," she added.

With the J&J Janssen vaccine, the benefits of the one-dose regimen far outweigh the risks. But, if people are worried, they can access Pfizer or Moderna COVID-19 vaccines. There have been more than 180 million doses of mRNA vaccines by Pfizer and Moderna administered with no reports of cerebral venous sinus thrombosis with thrombocytopenia.

Discover what to tell your patients when they ask which COVID-19 vaccine they should get.
