Diabetic Neuropathy

Diabetic neuropathy is nerve damage that occur in people with diabetes. Over a period of time, the nerve damage will cause pain, numbness, tingling, swelling or muscle weakness in different parts of the body. It usually begins in the hands or feet and get worse, if untreated. Let's focus our attention on how nerve damage can occur. Our nerves and blood vessels work closely together. Let's look at two situations we are familiar with. Our cars require some type of fuel or energy source to run, such as gas or electricity. Nerves need fuel as well, and blood has the fuel in the form of oxygen. This process maintains the nerves ability to work successfully, sending continuous messages to and from the brain, for activities of daily living. The energy produces a metabolic waste that should not remain around the nerves. Think about this – if our home waste removal service wasn't working, for some reason. It would be very difficult for us to function normally. Nerves require the same service from the blood. Removing the 'waste' and promoting a clean environment for nerves to function.

REMEMBER: Diabetic neuropathy is caused by the 'terrible three', mainly uncontrolled diabetes. But when high levels of cholesterol and high pressure occur, blood vessels become narrow and interfere with essential nutrients from reaching the nerves. As a result, the nerve fiber can become damaged and may disappear. Now you may have serious health problems, such as loss of feelings in your hands and feet. A diabetic must always remember to check their feet daily, for skin discoloration and any type of open areas, notifying their doctor immediately for all abnormal findings. The 'terrible three' will interfere with healing, causing a decrease blood supply to the skin on your feet. If a wound develops it will take a longer time to heal with medical care. There may be a possibility of gangrene, which could lead to amputation. Half of all the people with high levels of glucose (sugar) have some form of nerve damage.


