# **SHINGLES**

Shingles is a viral skin infection, affecting the nerve endings of the skin causing intense pain. It can occur anywhere on your body. Shingles is a skin rash that looks like a single stripe of watery blisters, wrapping around the leftor right side of your upper body. Sometimes the shingles' rash occurs around one eye or on one side of the face or neck. CAUSES: Shingles is caused by the varicella – zoster virus. It is same virus that cause the chickenpox. Anyonewho had chickenpox may develop shingles. After you recover from the chickenpox, the virus enters your nervous system and stays inactive for years. Sometimes the virus reactivates and travels along nerve pathways to yourskin, producing shingles. **GOOD TO KNOW:** Not everyone who had chickenpox will develop shingles. **UNDERSTAND:** Varicella – zoster is partof a group of viruses called herpes viruses. This is the group that includes theviruses that cause cold sores and genital herpes. As a result, shingles is alsoknown as herpes zoster. BUT the virus that causes chickenpox and shinglesisn't the same virus that causes cold sores or genital herpes.

**REMEMBER:** People who never had chickenpox or didn't get the chickenpox vaccine, can get infected. These people can get the virus through direct contact from the fluid of the shingles rash blisters. If they get infected, they will develop chickenpox. A person with shingles is contagious until the blisters are dried with scab formation. **OTHER RISK FACTORS:** Age – the risk of developing shingles increases with age. Shingles typically occurs in people older than 50. People over 60 are more likely to experience more severe complications. Diseases that weaken your immune system, such as HIV/AIDS and cancer with radiation or chemotherapy treatments, can increase your risk of shingles. Some medications that prevent rejection of transplanted organs and long-term use of steroids can trigger shingles. **SYMPTOMS:** A red rash, burning or tingling pain, Sensitivity to touch – most people can't tolerate clothing or bed linen to touch affected area, due to severe pain, itching, fever, headache and weakness. Contact your doctor immediately ifyou develop a painful skin rash in one area of your body.


