### Why Does God Allow Good People to Suffer? (Part 21)

Jesus also made it clear that He had come to suffer for sinners so their sins might be forgiven and they might have eternal life. "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many" (**Mark 10:45**).

What a difference our Lord brings about regarding our perspective on suffering. The world abhors the thought of suffering and cannot imagine how a loving God can allow it. God uses suffering to teach us how evil sin is and how devastating its consequences. He used the suffering of our Savior to forgive our sins. He continues to employ suffering to draw us closer to Him and to one another. Suffering for Christ's sake is not an enemy but a friend. Suffering is not something we need to seek, but it is something we should accept, knowing it comes from our Heavenly Father, who is the "Father of mercies," and the "God of all comfort."

**8** ... I count all things to be loss in view of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them but rubbish in order that I may gain Christ, ... **10** That I may know Him, and the power of His resurrection and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death (**Phil. 3:8, 10**).

One last thing must be said before concluding this lesson. This lesson is directed toward believers in Jesus Christ, just as this passage is written to true believers (**see 2 Cor. 1:1-2**). This is the reason I am able to use the title, "Why Bad Things Happen to God's People."

#### “Are You Wearing Your Mask Correctly?”

Improperly wearing a mask can increase your risk of COVID-19 contamination and infection. Face masks have become part of the new normal uniform in America following the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's recommendation that people wear them in public. But simply wearing one doesn't necessarily mean you're protected — or protecting anyone else.

Masks are meant to help prevent you from accidentally spreading or catching an infectious disease that, like COVID-19, is believed to primarily spread through respiratory droplets. Since 25% of people infected with the novel coronavirus may not be experiencing symptoms, according to an estimate from CDC director Dr. Robert Redfield, everyone is encouraged to wear masks to protect others while in public.

“We know that there are people that are asymptomatic that could spread the virus before they have symptoms. I think we need to work under the concept that anyone you run into could potentially infect you,” said Thomas Russo, the chief of the infectious disease division at the University of Buffalo. “That is the ugly reality of this epidemic.”

To help stop the spread of COVID-19, you need to put on your mask the right way and avoid making simple, yet consequential mistakes:
