Fever --- Good VS Bad

A fever occurs when the body's temperature rises above the individual's normal value. It is a good practice to know your normal temperature. Most adults' temperature varies between 97 to 99 degrees Fahrenheit. It can be influenced by age and during strenuous exercise causing a temporarily high rate of 104 F. Do you know your temperature changes during a day? You are coolest at night and warmest in the evening. WHY YOU GET A FEVER: Your body may raise its temperature to help you fight off an infection. When your body is hotter, it makes it harder for viruses or bacteria to survive. The fever also tells your immune system to make more white blood cells to join in the fight. SO A FEVER MAY HELP PROTECT YOU, EVEN IF IT MAKES YOU FEEL WORSE FOR A LITTLE WHILE.

HOW FEVER AFFECTS YOUR BODY: If you have a fever, you may feel hot and sweaty. Also you may shiver because you feel chilled. This is the body's reaction to raising a higher temperature, when fighting certain infections or diseases. A fever can be very unpleasant and may cause painful symptoms --- even when the cause is a relatively minor illness. Weakness, aches and tasteless food with a depressive behavior, is a high probability with a fever. If your temperature is 103 F or higher and the number doesn't drop after you take medicine to lower the number; notify your doctor. Other symptoms may occur such as ineffective fluid intake with decrease urination, severe headache, stiff neck, new skin rash and confusion. When this occur go to the emergency room. HOW TO BRING DOWN A FEVER: Over-the-counter medicines like Tylenol or Ibuprofen can ease a fever in adults and children older than 6 months. Cool yourself safely - take a bath in cool or lukewarm water. ** People should avoid adding rubbing alcohol to their bathwater. Any prolonged exposure to rubbing alcohol, can cause the skin to absorb and lead to toxicity in both children and adults. Rubbing alcohol can create a cooling sensation on the skin, but it will not lower a person's elevated internal temperature. Cold compresses to the forehead and neck can also help


