Some Valuable Nuggets on Forgiveness Ephesians 4:32 (Part 21)

A. BIBLICAL FORGIVENESS IS THE DECISION.

Before I tell you what this decision involves, let me underscore that it is a deliberate decision you must make. Here are other Aspects of Forgiveness:

To refuse to talk to others about the offense.

When you forgive, you choose to drop the matter. The only exception would be if you fear that the offender may be trying to repeat his sin toward another person, who needs to be warned of the danger.

For example, if someone has molested your child and you see him hanging out with another family with young children, it is appropriate to warn them to be on guard.

To be reconciled with the offender as far as is 5. biblically possible.

God forgives us so that we may be reconciled to Him and enjoy a close relationship with Him. When we forgive others. we should also seek to restore the broken relationship. This does not always mean becoming best of friends, but it should at least mean that we are cordial and friendly towards the person. To say, "I forgive you, but I never want to see your ugly face again," is not to forgive as God forgives!

HealthCare Ministry "The Delta Variant Unknown"- (Part 2)

So, what's the answer?

We still can't be sure, and future data could change the picture. But the evidence so far suggests that Delta is similarly severe to earlier versions of the virus, probably with only modest differences in one direction or the other.

These tentative conclusions come from three difference sources: expert opinion; research studies; and overall data on cases, hospitalizations and deaths. Let's take them one at a time:

1. Expert opinion

Because the evidence is still emerging and sometimes inconsistent, experts do not read it precisely the same way. Still, I have noticed the broad outlines of a consensus in recent interviews:

"Any difference is a small difference," Dr. Aaron Richterman of the University of Pennsylvania told me.

"On a per-infection basis, I don't think it's changed," Jennifer Nuzzo, the lead epidemiologist for the Johns Hopkins Covid-19 Testing Insights Initiative, said. "The risks to vaccinated people haven't really changed."

"It really is in the 'I don't know stage," Dr. Paul Sax of Brigham and Women's Hospital said.

Dr. Robert Wachter of the University of California, San Francisco, said: "I treat as if it might be a little more severe, but I don't know that it matters that much.
