We hope you will join us on this journey.



The Mental Effect of Cancer

Cancer is a life – threatening disease, with the ability to infiltrate and destroy normal body cells. Cancer can start anywhere in the human body, which is made up of trillions of cells. Normally, human cells grow and multiply through a process called cell division, to form new cells as the body needs them. When cells grow old or become damaged, they die and simultaneously new cells take their place. You need viable cells to have a normal functioning body – there is no time break in the system. What a marvelous creation God made.

When a person is first diagnosed, with the news – you have cancer – automatically, this will have a big impact on their mental status. Further health information affects more than a person's physical health. The emotional stress, uncertain prognosis (outcome), and physical pain can all take a toll on an individual's mental health. From processing the news of a cancer diagnosis to navigating a plan of care, is very important to focus on both the body and the mind. There may be noticeable changes in a person's behavior, you have never seen before. Such as mood swings, get angry or cry at unusual times or act differently in social situations. The will to live is a force within all of us to fight for survival when our lives are threatened by a disease such as cancer. However, depression, poor appetite, and poor self – esteem can make a big difference, in the lives of cancer patients.


