<u>Alopecia</u>

The medical term Alopecia refers to hair lost. Hair grows everywhere on the human skin except on places like the palms of our hands and the soles of our feet. However, many hairs are so fine they are virtually invisible – not easily seen. Hair is made of a protein called keratin, produced in hair follicles in the outer layer of skin. As follicles produce new hair cells, old cells are being pushed out through the surface of the skin at the rate of about 6 inches a year. The hair you can see is actually a string of dead keratin cells. This process sounds familiar. Remember, when body cells die because of old age or damage to cells, news cells simultaneously replace dead cells. The human body is truly remarkably, having the knowledge when to make new parts for daily body functioning. The average adult head has about 100,000 to 150,000 hairs and loses some of them a day. Finding a few stray hairs on your hairbrush is not necessarily a cause for alarm.

Hair loss can affect just your scalp or your entire body, it can be temporary or permanent. It can be the results of heredity, hormonal changes, medical conditions or a normal part of aging. Anyone can lose hair on their head, but it's more common in men. Alopecia is an autoimmune disease and can be unpredictable. In some people, with treatments their hair grows back but later falls out again. In others, their hair grows back and never falls out again. Alopecia can have a significant impact on your mental health --- affecting how an individual feel about themselves.


