
"6 Places You're Most Likely to Catch Coronavirus" (Pt.2) Submitted by: Beatrice Ramsey

Some places are riskier than others to visit. In general, infection hot spots tend to be "indoor environments with limited fresh airflow, where large numbers of people can gather for longer than 10 minutes of interactions and where it is difficult to maintain physical distancing," according to Boris Lushniak, MD, Dean of the University of Maryland School of Public Health in Baltimore. When planning your future public outings, consider avoiding these everyday places where experts say infection rates remain the highest.

Bars and Restaurants

The number one hot spot for coronavirus infections is the bar and restaurant scene, according to Dr. Lushniak. "Unfortunately, as bars have reopened, we have seen a large number of young people gathering but not necessarily being wary that COVID-19 is still a problem," he says. The data backs him up: A study in the CDC's Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Report found that adults who tested positive for COVID-19 were twice as likely to have dined at a restaurant as those who tested negative.

Even bars and restaurants that limit capacity and space tables six feet apart are high-risk environments, Dr. Lushniak says. At bars, in particular, people gather as they wait in line to get in, and most don't wear masks or socially distance. Inside, people spend hours in a small, poorly ventilated space while dancing, eating, sitting or standing close together, and talking over the music.
