## HealthCare Ministry

### The Flu Viruses

There are four types of influenza viruses: A, B, C and D. Influenza A and B cause seasonal epidemic, almost every winter in the United States. Together they can affect people with little or no immunity to fight the flu viruses. Influenza C virus infection generally cause mild illness and don't cause human epidemics. Influenza D viruses primarily affects cattle and are not known to infect or cause illness in people.

#### How Flu Spreads:

People with the flu can spread the disease to others. Most experts think the flu virus spreads mainly by droplets made when people with the flu coughs, sneeze or talk. These droplets can land in the mouths or noses of people who are nearby ( usually less than 6 feet away ) and inhaled into the lungs. Less often a person might get the flu by touching a surface or object that has the flu virus on it. Unaware of the virus, touch their own mouth, nose or possibly their eyes without washing their hands. REMEMBER – we are still in the wear your mask, maintain social 6 feet distance and wash your hands situation.

#### When Are People With The Flu Contagious?

Flu viruses can be detected in most infected persons beginning one day before symptoms develop and up to five to seven days after becoming sick. People with the flu are most contagious in the first three to four days after their illness begins. However, infants and people with weakened immune systems who are infected with the flu viruses may be contagious for longer than seven days. It is theoretically possible, before symptoms begin, an infected person can spread flu viruses to their close contacts. Some people can be infected with a flu virus and have no symptoms, but may still be able to spread the virus to their close contacts.

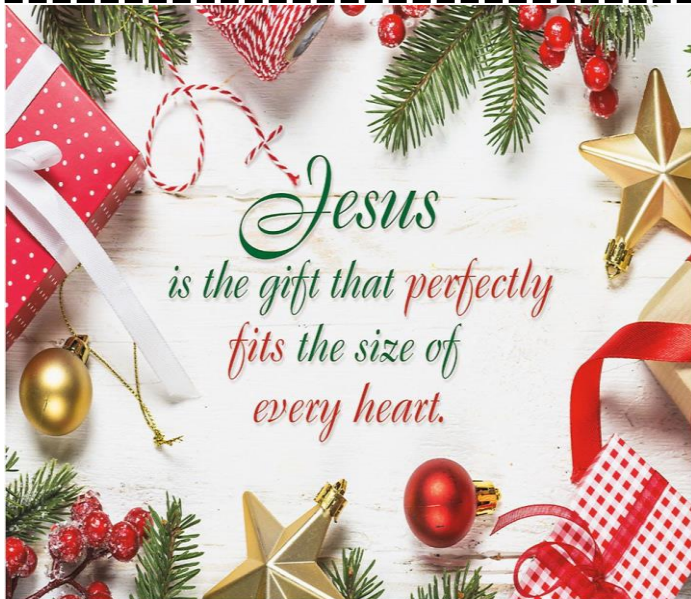
