Gastroenteritis

Gastroenteritis is an infection, occurring after eating or drinking contaminated food and water. You may also obtain this disease, when you share utensils, towels or food with someone who has this illness. It is spread from your stomach into your intestines, causing symptoms. Whenever this occurs, the immune system sends inflammatory cells to fight the infection and repair injured tissues. Symptoms include, diarrhea, nausea, vomiting, stomach pain and fever. This disease can affect anyone, including infants and children. Everyone at some point in their life, have experienced stomach problems after eating or drinking something that upset their digestive system.

GOOD TO KNOW: The most common causes are viruses, bacteria, fungi or parasites. The other causes are your toxic chemicals, which can contaminate the food and water sources. You can also get it from heavy doses of alcohol / drugs and some medications – know your side effects. Symptoms usually appear several hours or within a day after becoming infected. Depending on the length of time and severity of illness, remember to contact your doctor.


