Bacterial And Viral Sore Throats

A sore throat is something we are all familiar with, but it's not easy to tell if it is a bacteria or a virus infection. This can be confusing when you are trying to treat the disease. Keep in mind, the symptoms and progression of a bacterial sore throat is entirely different from a viral sore throat. They are both contagious, however a viral infection doesn't respond to antibiotics the way a bacterial infection does. Painful swallowing is common to both bacterial and viral sore throats. Bacterial sore throat often come with red swollen tonsils, white patches or streaks of pus and a higher severe fever, than a viral infection.

A viral sore throat has a different presentation. It occurs most often during symptoms of a common cold. Unlike bacterial sore throat, a viral sore throat always have a cough. This is the way the body eliminates foreign substances from your lungs and may last up to two weeks. Also viral sore throat will have redness and swelling at the back of the mouth without the white patches of pus. Runny noses, hoarseness and fever are also common symptoms. When symptoms occur notify your doctor for correct treatments.


