Sickle Cell Disease --- SCD

Sickle cell abnormal blood disease, inherited from both parents. Interesting fact: SCD can be diagnosed while the baby is in the mother's womb. Two ways of testing (1) using a tiny piece of the placenta (2) small amount of amniotic fluid surrounding the baby. Blood cells are made in the bone marrow, a spongy tissue, mainly found in the spine, hips, ribs and breastbone. In children, the main center for blood cells production is in the femur. A stem cell is the first phase of all blood cells. Once the stem cell has fully matured, in about seven days, several different types of cells develop into either red blood cells, white blood cells or platelets. In SCD, red blood cells become hard and sticky, looking like a C – shaped farm tool and they stick together blocking blood flow, interfering with the body's ability to supply oxygen to body parts. SCD blood cells do not move easily, dies early causing a stroke. One of the main problems with SCD, is a sudden pain crisis, requiring hospital management.

Sickle cell trait occurs when one gene is inherited from one parent. Most people with SCT occasional will have health problems. This occurs when there are two sickle cell genes in the body. Such as dehydration or strenuously exercise. Some people are born with SCT, until a health issue appear.



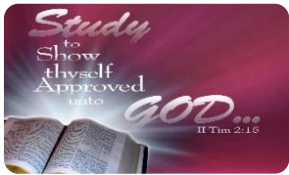
