

Lupus Disease

Lupus is a chronic (long–term) disease that can cause inflammation and pain, in any part of your body. It's an autoimmune disease, which means that your immune system, that usually fights infections, attacks healthy tissues instead. The good part about lupus, it's not contagious—you can't "catch" lupus or give it to someone else. The exact cause of lupus is unknown. Researchers are studying what might cause or trigger the disease. Such as genetics, viral infections, sunlight, certain medications, smoking and problems with the immune system. Good to know-anyone can get lupus, but women get it much more than men. **Remember:** there is no cure for lupus, treatments can help control symptoms. Lupus affects people of all ages, most often diagnosed between 15–45. It is more common in African Americans, Hispanics and Asian Americans. Also, people who has a family member with lupus or another autoimmune disease is highly susceptible to having lupus.

Lupus can be difficult to diagnose because symptoms often mimic other ailments. The most distinctive sign of lupus is a red facial rash, resembling the open wings of a butterfly, across both cheeks and bridge of nose. Fortunately, this does not occur in all cases. Contact your doctor if any uncontrolled fever, persistent pain, fatigue and skin lesion that worsen with sun exposure occurs.




