Grieving Stages – Part 1

Grieving is a normal healthy emotional response to the loss of a family member, friend or other significant losses such as a divorce, uncurable illness, employment and finances. Not everyone grieves the same way. Some goes through all the stages of grieving, or they may not grieve in the same order. The main purpose of the grieving stages helps to be knowledgeable about how to cope with life and loss. Sometimes when we try to console the grieving person, it may be hard to offer the right words of consolation. We must be careful what we say, because sometimes what you may think are words of comfort, may actually be hurtful to the bereaved person. Comments such as, “he / she is better off – in a better place”. Telling them the deceased person is better off dead. Remember your place is to console, not to judge.

DENIAL: When you first learn of a loss, it's common to think, “This isn't happening.” You may feel shocked or numb. This is a temporary way to deal with the rush of overwhelming emotions. It's a defense mechanism.

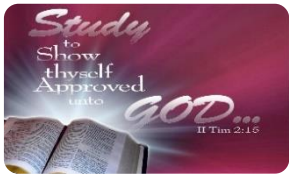

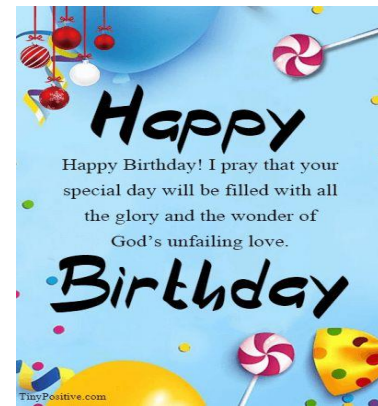
