From the Minister's Desk


To our distinguished visitors:

Understanding Memory Loss - Part 2

Last week part 1 gave a good explanation on understanding memory loss. Today we will focus our attention on risk factors and mental stimulating activities. Remember, a risk factor is something that will increase the chance of developing a disease or illness. 1) Age – the most common cause in memory loss. As we age our physical, mental and social lifestyle activities begin declining, from loss of interest in life for most older adults. 2) High blood pressure – decreases thinking and reasoning abilities, because of decrease blood supply to the brain. 3) Smokers – between 43 to 53, who smoked more than 20 cigarettes a day, memory decline is faster. The older you get severe memory decline will occur. 4) Alcohol – regular heavy drinking can damage the brain leading to severe memory and thinking loss. 5) Decrease mental stimulation – will cause memory loss from social isolation, as you age.

Mental Stimulating Activities: It maybe a good idea to try several different kinds of brain training activities at first, then stick to those that are fun to you. These activities decrease memory loss: crossword puzzles / word search games / chess or checkers board games / reading book club / new hobbies – painting / knitting / dancing.






