Blood Cancers ---- Part 1

Blood cancers are tumors that affect the blood, bone marrow and the lymphatic system. When cancer occurs in the blood, it's usually the result of an abnormal and excessive reproduction of white blood cells. Blood cancers accord for 10 percent of all diagnosed cancers in America each year. **LEUKEMIA:** involves the white blood cells, your infection fighters. They normally grow and divide in an orderly way, as your body needs them. But in people with leukemia, the bone marrow produces an excessive amount of abnormal white blood cells, which don't function properly. Leukemia can be classified as chronic (slow growing) or acute (fast growing).

Multiple myeloma, another cancer of the blood occurs when abnormal plasma cells a form of white blood cells, build up in the bone marrow and form a tumor. Normally healthy plasma cells produce and release protein antibodies to attack and eliminate germs, when needed. **DID YOU KNOW:** men are more likely to develop this disease than women and Afro-American are twice as likely to develop this disease than Caucasians.




