
#### From the Minister's Desk



#### Blood Cancers ---- Part 2

Last week we discussed two types of blood cancerous diseases, Leukemia and Multiple Myeloma. Today's healthcare discussion will include information on Lymphomas. They occur when the DNA in blood cells is damaged, causing the cells to multiply abnormally, preventing white blood cells from performing their normal function (infection – fighters). There are several types of lymphoma, we will discuss the two major types and their differences. Hodgkin Lymphoma usually is the painless swelling of the lymph nodes located in the armpit, neck, and chest areas. However, some people will experience pain in affected lymph nodes after drinking alcoholic beverages. Hodgkin Lymphoma is more curable because it only affects certain areas of the body. Non – Hodgkin Lymphoma spreads to larger areas of the body's lymph nodes, liver, spleen, and stomach. These areas are very painful with longer recovery time, depending on the severity of the cancer.

Symptoms includes: night sweats, weight loss, vulnerable for infection with poor healing, feeling tried, weak, difficult breathing, intense skin itching with scaly or rough patches. Contact your doctor when these symptoms occur unrelieved.


