

Breast Cancer Awareness

There are many different forms of breast cancer, and each type may have multiple variations. Noninvasive Breast Cancer – means your disease is located in the milk ducts, where it started and has not spread to anywhere else, in the breast or other parts of the body. This ductal cancer is the most common form of noninvasive breast cancer. In it's original place, it is a stage O cancer. It is also the earliest and the most treatable form of breast cancer. Although it was noninvasive when it was diagnosed, left untreated over a period of time it can become invasive. Another type is Invasive Breast Cancer. This means the cancer has spread beyond it's original location, invading other parts of the breast and possibly the lymph nodes. Over time may spread to other parts of the body. Tubular Carcinoma consists of small tube-shaped tumors, less aggressive and slow-growing disease. They are diagnosed most often in women in their 50's. It usually doesn't spread beyond the breast and respond well to treatment. Mucinous Carcinoma consist of cancer cells that "float" in pools of mucin (thin liquid mucus). This cancer affects post-menopausal women in their 60's and 70's, less aggressive and responds well to treatments.




