

Bone Cancer

Bone cancer is a malignant tumor that develop when cells, in the bone grow out of control. There are two types of bone cancer – primary this type starts inside the bone. Secondary spreads to the bone from another part of the body. Bone cancer is more common in children, adolescents and young adults. It is very rare in adults over 40 years of age.

Let's look at the four stages of bone cancer: Stage 1 – the cancer cells are localized and considered low grade. Stage 2 – the cancer is still localized but considered high grade. Stage 3 – the cancer cells are still localized in the bone and has spread to several different places within the same bone. Stage 4 – the most advance cancer of this disease, has spread to other areas of the body. Good To Know – The term 'bone cancer' doesn't include cancer that starts from another part of the body and spread to the bones. The cancer is named from the place it began, such as cancer that spread from the lungs to the bones is still lung cancer with metastasis. Symptoms; pain and swelling at the affected bone, weak and easy broken bones, weight loss without trying. Notify your doctor immediately, if you have severe unrelieved pains doing body movements




