
#### From the Minister's Desk



#### <u> Dietary Supplements – Part 2</u>

There are 8 different B vitamins. They are all water soluble, which means they are not stored by your body. You must eat them daily for the best effects. However, there is one exception - excessive amounts of vitamin B-12 is stored in the liver. Vitamin B-1 helps convert the food eaten into energy for cellular activities. Also, it is important for adequate nerve cell functions. Vitamin B-2 is needed for energy production and to make sure the other B vitamins are doing their jobs. Vitamin B-3 is one of the ingredients in skin care products, helping with anti – aging effects, clears up eczema and acne. Vitamin B-5 helps to build and break down fatty acids. It is a popular ingredient for some skin and hair care products. Vitamin B 6 is probable one of the most famous B vitamins. It helps to maintain correct levels of amino acid, which your body naturally produces. But too much of it can lead to things like blood clots, hardened arteries, heart attacks and nerve damage. Vitamin B 9 (folate) is critical for proper formation of the neural tube (the structure that forms the early brain and spine in a developing fetus). Low folate can raise a risk for birth defects. Vitamin B 12 helps with the production of red blood cells and DNA. Also is important with helping maintain organs and brain functions.
