

Cold Winter Illnesses

This is the season for sharing cold germs, flu viruses, stomach bugs and more. Cold weather months capture that magical time when your sneezy co-worker insist on coming in for a meeting instead of staying home.

Remember, when you catch a winter illness, symptoms don't always pop up right away. It could take up to a few days or a week for symptoms to appear.

By the time you start showing cold or flu symptoms, you probably had given the germ or virus to at least one other person. This depends on which germ or virus you had contacted and the strength of your immune system. Good to know: You are usually most contagious two to three days after you are infected. However, you can infect others for two weeks or longer while recovering from a common cold or flu. Understand, you are contagious during the entire period of ALL symptoms, until they *ALL* disappear. Flu season runs from October to May, but it's possible to be infected with this virus anytime of the year.

Notify your doctor, if you have a fever above 102 F, difficult breathing, wheezing, coughing, chest/throat/head pains, uncontrolled nasal congestion, severe weakness, dark discolored urine and dizziness.


