

The Effect of Pain And Dyspnea


Researchers have concluded that dyspnea (shortness of breath) and pain are strongly associated. Both symptoms warn individuals, there is a threat to their normal health status, requiring immediate medical attention. The cooccurrence between dyspnea and pain display closeness in older adults, because both of these symptoms and other health conditions, increases during aging. Examples: chest pains, back pains, arthritis, asthma and emphysema.

GOOD TO KNOW: pain can indeed cause shortness of breath and vice versa. Pain especially in the chest or abdomen, .

can trigger a physical response that leads to shallow or fast breathing, making you feel like you are out of breath. Additionally, pain can be associated with anxiety or stress, which can also worsen breathing difficulties. When experiencing pain, the body may automatically react by taking short shallow breaths. This happens, because pain can cause muscle tension, in the chest and diaphragm (a muscle that separate the chest from the abdomen) making it harder to breathe deeply and effectively. Summary: pain and shortness of breath can have a great impact on your life.


