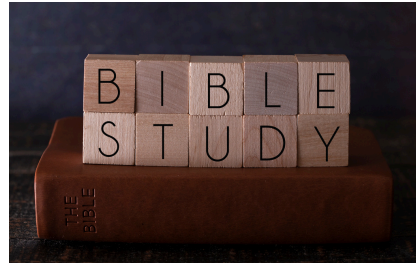

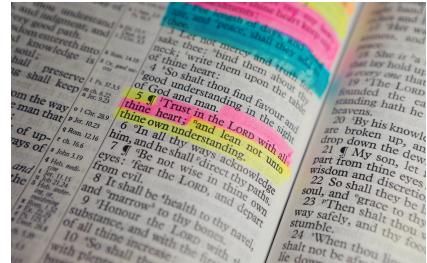

Health Challenges of Chronic Diseases: Part 2

Arthritis is more of an autoimmune disease, but there is another risk factor that is more severe. Infectious arthritis is a general term that refers to any arthritic condition caused by microorganisms, such as bacteria, virus and fungus. These germs are so small and can only be visible under a microscope. They have the ability to be transmitted from one infected area by circulating blood for colonization (a place for growth) inside joints. Only bacteria has receptor cells that binds to the walls of the fluid sack (synovial membrane) which makes fluid for smooth movements of joints. Bacterial receptors interferes with smooth movements and is the most common causative agent. Infectious arthritis is also known as septic arthritis,

because they are an extension of a present infection, somewhere inside the body. **GOOD TO KNOW:** Germs that can cause infections might enter the body through surgery, open wounds or injections. Arthritis generally affects only one joint at a time. The knee, hip, elbow, wrist and finger are the most common joints affected by septic arthritis. Symptoms includes: in the affected joint, pain, fever, chills and swelling. Although symptoms may vary from person to person. Other risk factors that increase the risk of septic arthritis are diabetes, alcoholism, HIV, old age, lung and liver disorders.


