

Understanding Respiratory Viral Mutation

There are some things you can count on as fall turns into winter. The days get shorter, temperature gets colder and chances are a respiratory flu virus is beginning to spread. The flu season, in the United States usually starts in October and tapers off in late April. But this can change from year to year depending on location. Of course, the flu is a viral respiratory infection, affecting people of all ages. Let's look at the known facts. All viruses are parasites, they completely depend on living cells within a live person, for their reproduction and metabolic process. Simply because they were not made with a reproductive and metabolic system. Once inside a living host, the viruses attach themselves to the walls of a host cell, injecting their genetic material. They take control, commanding the host cells to make many copies of itself forming new viral particles. **Good To Know:** When a virus replicates itself, it doesn't always manage to produce the exact copy of itself. When this change occurs the virus is known as a "new strain". However, all viral mutations are variants. But the difference is when there is a genetic change in the virus sequence, it then becomes a new strain and a variant at the same time. Once the virus is freed and spread to another host, the reproduction process is repeated UNTIL.
