Understanding Lupus

There are many health-related diseases that require medical help to control and eliminate symptoms. Let's take a close look at Lupus, an autoimmune disease that affects mainly Black People, mostly women. Our bodies have a build – in defense system, to attack and destroy unwanted invaders. This defense system is known as the immune system, keeping the body healthy by making antibodies to target and destroy all invaders. Once the invaders and the infections caused by the invaders are controlled, the immune response stops and the body will begin to restore itself back to normal functioning. Unfortunately, sometimes the immune system mistakenly cannot tell the difference between a foreign material (invader) and a normal body bacteria. Resulting in wrongly attacking the body's healthy cells and tissues, with an inappropriate immune response. This can cause inflammation and internal damage to any body part.

Good To Know: Find out which factors are causing your body to attack itself. By eliminating the cause, the disease process can enter remission. According to Manhattan Lupus Surveillance Program, African American women Lupus rates are three times higher than female Caucasians. Also, Hispanic women Lupus rates are two times higher and Asian women are 1.4 times higher than female Caucasians. Men can be affected with Lupus, but the ratio is low. Symptoms include painful joints, severe weakness, facial rash, mouth sores and swelling of face, hands and feet.
