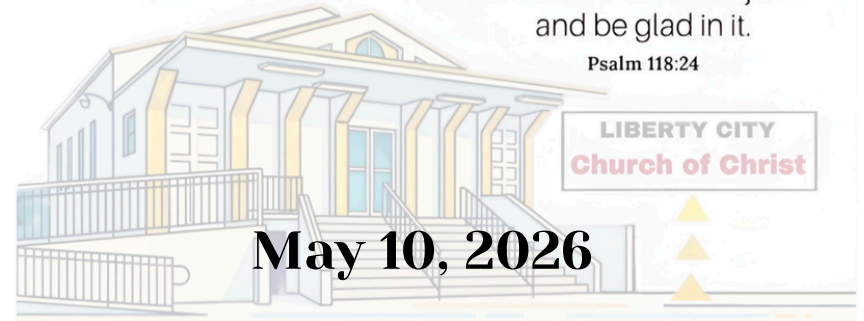

Understanding Juvenile Rheumatoid Arthritis part 2

Last week Healthcare Article was the introduction of Juvenile Rheumatoid Arthritis. Reiterating, JRA is an autoimmune disease, which mean the body mistakenly identifies some of its own cells and tissues as foreign. The result is inflammation – redness, heat, pain and swelling. JRA affect any child 16 years or younger. Unlike adult rheumatoid arthritis, which is ongoing (chronic) and last a lifetime, children often outgrow JRA. But the disease can affect bone development in a growing child. The plan of treatment is to reduce pain, swelling and stiffness, helping your child to keep a normal lifestyle as much as possible. However, medication such as steroids can also interfere with growth.

Statistically speaking, health studies of JRA indicates that if one identical twin develop JRA, their identical sibling has a 25% - 40% of developing JRA. Health studies involving non-identical twins, show evidence that if one sibling has JRA, there is 15% - 30% times an increased risk that their sibling will develop JRA. However, researchers are currently studying JRA for better understanding of effective treatments and ultimately a cure for JRA. Systemic JRA involves one or more joints, associated with a 2 weeks of daily spiking fever of 102 F. The fever usually spikes once or twice daily and may have the unique pattern of returning to below normal between rises. Usually this happens between 3 – 5 years of age. Pauciarticular (paw-see-are-tick-you-lar) means 4 or fewer joints are involved and is the most common type of JRA. Affecting large joints (knees), girls under 8 yrs of age most likely to develop this type of JRA. Remember to keep all doctor's appointments and follow all health instructions
