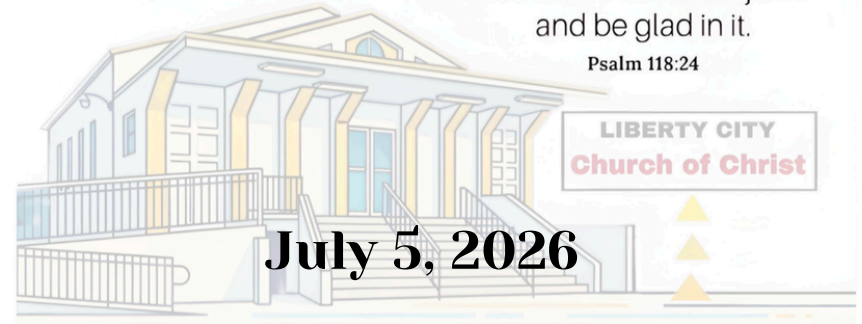

Summertime – Guess who is coming to dinner

Summertime is the most enjoyable time of the year. We have more outside fun activities with families and friends. Long sleeves and long length pants are no longer required. However, we are not the only ones who enjoy the warm weather with the opportunity for selective eating. **GUESS WHO AM I?** Mosquitoes are small flying insects. They have six legs and long mouthparts, used to feed on blood and nectar from flowers. Remember, only female mosquitoes feed on blood and nectar, but the male mosquitoes feed on nectar only. The female mosquitoes need a blood meal to obtain the protein and nutrients required before her eggs can be fully developed.

Good to know: Mosquitoes are attracted by carbon dioxide we exhale, also body heat, sweat and the odor released by our skin. Researchers reported, her bite is usually less than a minute, unless she is disturbed. She lands immediately penetrating the skin, releasing a small amount of saliva. This occurs before she draws blood. Her saliva contains a mixture of protein that prevent blood clotting, so the blood can keep flowing. Also the saliva prevent constriction of the blood vessel, which helps the blood to move easily. The saliva interferes with the body's platelet function, making it harder for the body to seal off the tiny wound. During this fast process, the body's immune system recognizes the mosquito's saliva as a foreign substance. Immediately releases histamine which causes itching, redness and swelling. When the swelling or bump appears, the mosquito leaves with her blood meal. *Remember*, some mosquitoes do carry diseases. Topical skin creams may relieve itching and mild discomfort, but contact your doctor for severe body pains and unrelieved fever.
